**PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT PERIOD: July 4–August 3, 2021**

The Department of the Navy (Navy), will host a **virtual** public meeting and invites interested members of the public to attend the virtual meeting to discuss and provide comments on the **Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA)** for a non-time critical removal action (NTCRA) at Munitions Response Program (MRP) Site 2, the Former Small Arms Range, at Naval Air Facility (NAF) El Centro in El Centro, California.

The EE/CA is an environmental document that describes past environmental activities conducted at MRP Site 2 and summarizes the results of the investigations at this site. The EE/CA also provides the analysis of potential solutions to address contamination, protect public health, and the environment, and identifies the preferred alternative based on a comparative analysis. The preferred alternative from the EE/CA is Excavation and Offsite Disposal (identified as Alternative 3 in the document) and would be implemented as a NTCRA. A NTCRA is conducted when a response action is determined to be necessary, but a planning period of at least six months is available before activities begin.

The EE/CA is one of the final stages of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act process in which the Navy solicits public input before the selection of a final remedy or decision.

The Navy is seeking public input and invites interested members of the public to review and comment on the EE/CA for MRP Site 2 during the 30-day public comment period from **July 4 through August 3, 2021**.
