
#### WELCOME

#### **Unexploded Ordnance (UXO)**

El Centro ranges are littered with practice **bombs**, **rockets**, **missiles**, and **bullets**.

Some of these munitions may have malfunctioned into what is known as unexploded ordnance (UXO).

The U.S. Navy is committed to characterizing and remediating these sites to a condition consistent with their intended use.

WARNING: Disturbing a UXO (touched, picked up, kicked, thrown, etc) may EXPLODE without warning, making it potentially hazardous even life threatening!!!



#### **UXO Characteristics:**

- Different shapes and sizes
- Look New, Old, or Rusty
- Look like Bullets or Bombs





- Look like pointed metal pipes, soda cans, small balls, or even an old car muffler
- Clearly visible or partially or completely hidden
- Virtually impossible to recognize as a military munition

#### What to do if something looks like a UXO?

RECOGNIZE!!! - Remember: Color, Size, Shape

**RETREAT!!!** – Exit the Way you Arrived

REPORT!!! - Notify Range Operations (760) 339-2616



A laser is as safe or as hazardous as the user. The military's knowledge and skill are paramount in ensuring laser training is safely managed.



**WARNING:** Military training with lasers is certified safe *only* outside designated range boundaries.



#### **Eye Injury Hazards**



The eye is the most sensitive organ to light. The major danger of laser radiation is hazards from beams entering the eye.




**Blinking** (aversion response) - is the eye's self-defense mechanism. However, it is not fast enough to prevent damage to the eye form military high powered lasers which can damage can an eye in less than a ¼ of a second.

#### Other Eye Injury Symptoms:

- Headache shortly after exposure
- Excessive watering of the eyes
- Sudden appearance of tiny spots or threads that drift in your field of vision.





#### **Other Laser Hazards**

WARNING: High-powered military lasers will set clothes on fire, burn exposed skin, and potentially melt metal and plastic products.
