1. Dolphin Scholarship: Deadline ~ 15 March 2016 ~ www.dolphinscholarship.org

The Dolphin Scholarship Foundation grants are available, on a competitive basis, to high school or college children/stepchildren (unmarried, under age 24 at time of deadline) of:

- (1) members or former members of the Submarine Force who have qualified in submarines and have served in the Submarine Force for at least eight years; or of
- (2) Navy members who have served in submarine support activities (e.g., submarine bases, tenders, and rescue vessels) for a minimum of ten years.

2. Navy Officers' Spouse Club (NOSC) Scholarships: Deadline 15 March

NOSC has two scholarship opportunities available for either seniors graduating from a greater San Diego Area high school during the year of application or spouses of an Active Duty, retired, medically retired, or deceased US Navy, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard who has served in a San Diego area command at some time; or Reservist activated for at least nine months.
