**WHY YOU ARE BEING NOTIFIED:** The Department of the Navy, in coordination with state and federal environmental regulatory agencies, has issued two **Proposed Plans** for public review and comment. The Proposed Plans were prepared for **the Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Site 1 Former Ship Repair Basins 3 and 4 and IRP Site 20 Shore Intermediate Maintenance Activity Transportation Facility, at Naval Base San Diego (NBSD), San Diego, California.**

**BACKGROUND:** The Proposed Plans summarize the results of the investigations at IRP Sites 1 and 20 and explain the basis of the proposed actions recommended to protect the public.

The Navy invites interested members of the public to review and comment on the Proposed Plans for IRP Sites 1 and 20. Public comments must be submitted in writing and postmarked or e-mailed no later than **December 31, 2021**. Comments may also be provided verbally during the public meeting on December 2, 2021. **PUBLIC MEETING:** The Navy will host a public meeting to discuss the Proposed Plans, answer questions, and accept comments. The meeting will be held on **Thursday, December 2, 2021 from 4:30 p.m. until 5:30 p.m.** at Naval Base San Diego Building 3210, Anchors Catering & Conference Center, located at 2375 Recreation Way, San Diego, CA 92136. Building 3210 is open to the public and within an area outside of Naval Base San Diego at the intersection of Main St. and Yama St. across from the I-5 South on-ramp. Please wear a mask while inside the building, and follow applicable CDC precautions related to COVID-19.
